Solutions

Solution 1:

Equation I: $x^2+2x-3 = 0$

$$x^2+3x-x-3 = 0$$

$$x(x+3) - 1(x+3) = 0$$

$$x = 1 / -3$$

Equation II: $y^2 + y + 12 = 0$

$$y^2 + 4y + 3y + 12 = 0$$

$$y(y+4) + 3(y+4) = 0$$

$$y = -3 / -4$$

Solution 2:

Equation I: $x^2 + 2x - 8 = 0$

$$x^2 + 4x - 2x - 8 = 0$$

$$x(x+4) - 2(x+4) = 0$$

$$x = 2 / -4$$

Equation II: $y^2 - 12y + 36 = 0$

$$y^2 - 6y - 6y + 36 = 0$$

$$y(y-6) - 6(y-6) = 0$$

$$y = 6$$

Solution 3:

Let the initial wage = $22x$

Final wage = $25x$

Let the initial labourers = $3y$

Final labourers = $2y$

Final bill = $25x \times 2y = 5000$

$$xy = 100$$

Hence, the original wage bill = $22x \times 3y = 66xy = \text{Rs.}6600$

Solution 4:

Price of a table after 10% increase = $3000 + 300 = 3300$

Price of a chair after 20% increase = $1000 + (20\% \text{ of } 1000) = 1200$

Cost of 10 tables and 20 chairs = $10 \times 3300 + 20 \times 1200 = \text{Rs.}57000$

Solution 5:

Let's assume the initial speed of Karan is x kmph

Now after increasing his speed by 4 kmph his final speed = $x+4$ kmph

According to the question:

$$(80/x) - [80/(x+4)] = 1$$

$$x^2 + 4x - 320 = 0$$

$$(x-16)(x+20) = 0$$

$$x = 16 \text{ kmph}$$

Final speed = $16 + 4 = 20$ kmph

Solution 6:

Percentage change in speed
 $= [(20-16) / 16] \times 100$
 $= 25\%$

$3 + 1 = 4$
 $4 + 2 = 6$

Solution 10: 'Verbiage' means overabundance or superfluity of words, while 'forbearance' is the only word which collocates with the word 'calm' and fits right into the context.

Solution 11: The sentence is telling us how Apple, as a multinational company is uncommunicative, which allows us to infer that analysts have to rely on guesswork to decide its future positions and strategies. Thus 'surmise' can be filled in the first blank. The 2nd blank can be filled with 'facile' as it means ignoring the true complexities of the issue.

Solution 12: Choice (a) is incorrect. The correct idiom here is 'laugh up your sleeve' or 'laugh in your sleeve'. The rest of the usage is correct.

Solution 13: Answer (d) has the incorrect usage of the word 'cut'. The correct sentence should be 'He wasn't cut out for priesthood.'

Solution 14: The paragraph refers to the thinking of Spencer and Marx. Despite their intellectual differences had similar ideological leaning. Taking this into account choice (c) is the most logical way to arrange the sentences

Solution 15: Statement 'b' introduces the topic. Statement 'e' extends the thought that lifestyles overlap in different cultures. Statement 'd' is more specific about lifestyles and exemplifies statement 'e'. Statement 'a' then follows with the explanation of why entanglements result. Statement 'c' concludes the paragraph. Choice 'b' is incorrect as it cannot come before statement 'e'. Thus choice 'c' - bedac' is the right choice.

Solution 16: Option C is the most appropriate answer as it contains no grammatical error.

Solution (17): (a) Only assumption (I) is implicit. Assumption (II) is incorrect as the response of the residents cannot be deduced from the statement given.

Solution (18): (a) Only assumption (I) is implicit because John stops troubling his father after the warning.

Solution (19): (e) If major changes are being stressed it must be assumed that the present education system needs a major overhaul. Thus (I) is implicit. On the other hand, if (I) is implicit, (II) is also implicit because it correlates with each other.

Solution 20: (e) 'Conductor will be coded as either 'ri' or 'pa'

Solution 21: (b) 'ya pu di' will represent 'yours computer bank'

Solution 22: (e) So, 'pa' stands for either 'for' or 'conductor'
