(For example, over-speeding by motorists, not wearing helmet/seat belt and use of mobile phone while driving). What are the problems in enforcement? Can you suggest some ways in which enforcement can be improved?
- **7**. A 'clean environment is a public facility.' Can you explain this statement?
- **8.** Why are companies and contractors able to violate environmental laws?
- **9**. Can you think of other ways in which the environment can be protected? Discuss.
- 10. What are the advantages to foreign companies in setting up production in India?
- 11. Do you think the victims of the Bhopal gas tragedy got justice? Discuss.
- 12. What do we mean when we speak of law enforcement? Who is responsible for enforcement?
- **13**. How can laws ensure that markets work in a manner that is fair? Give two examples to support your answer.
- **14.** What are the sources of environmental pollution in your area? Discuss with respect to (a) air; (b) water and (c) soil. What are the steps being taken to reduce pollution? Can you suggest some other measures?
