Question 1:

Who lived in the cottage in the forest?

Answer:

There lived a Bear family lived in the cottage in the forest.

Question 2:

What did Curlylocks see on the table?

Answer:

Curlylocks saw three bowls of porridge on the table. The big bowl was for Papa Bear, the middle size bowl for Mama Bear and a tiny little bowl for Baby Bear.

Question 3:

Why did she eat up all the porridge from Baby Bear's bowl?

Answer:

Curlylocks was very hungry. She ate all the porridge from from Baby Bear's bowl as it was neither too hot nor too cold, just right for her.

Question 4:

Whose bed did Curlylocks sleep in and why?

Answer:

Curlylocks slept in the tiny little bed which was perfect for her as it was neither very hard nor too soft.

Fat: My uncle Tom is very **fat**.

Big: A giraffe has a **big** and long neck.
