**Answer:**

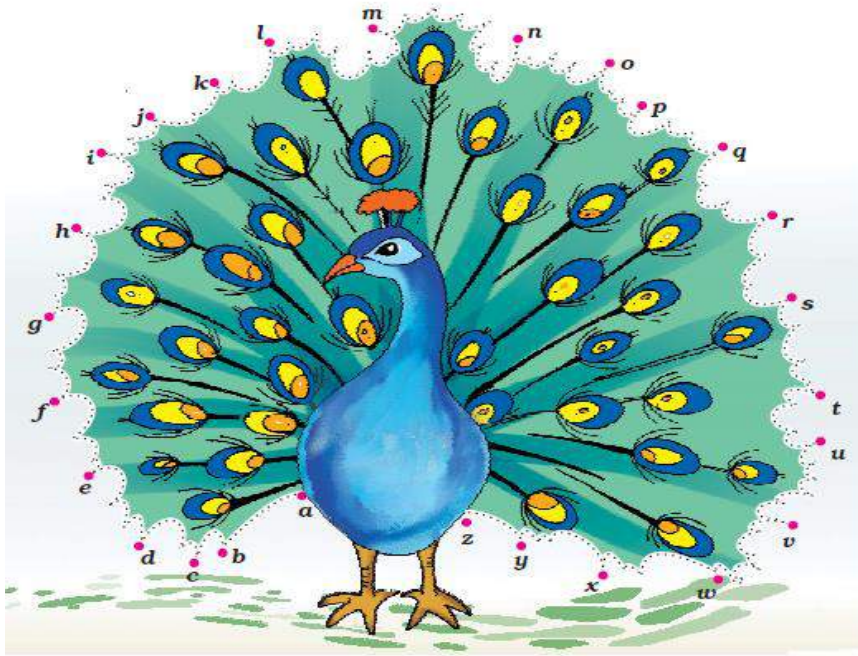
Yes, I've tried talking to birds whenever they come and sit on my window.

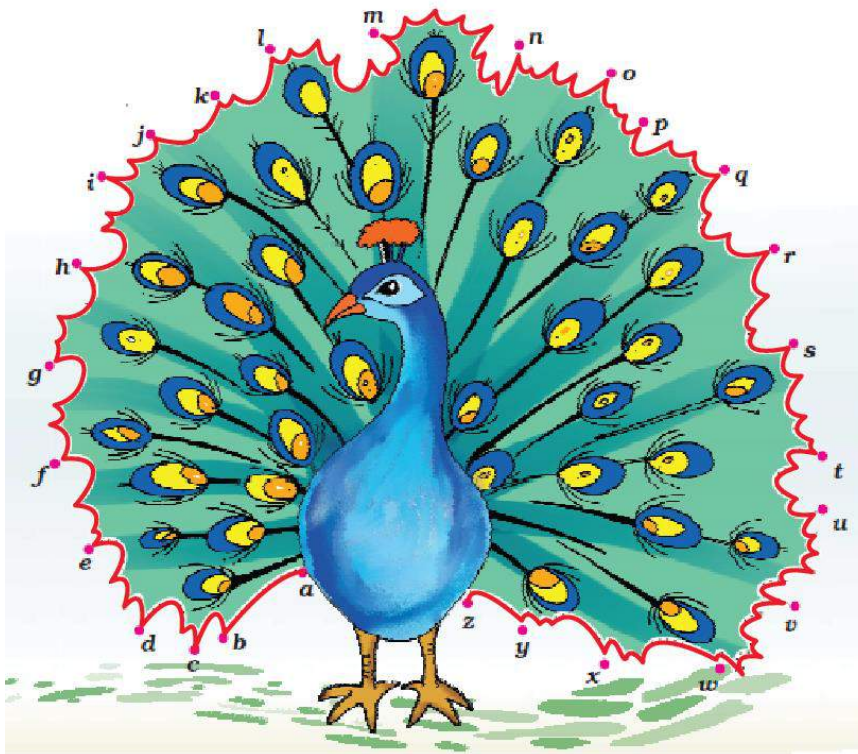

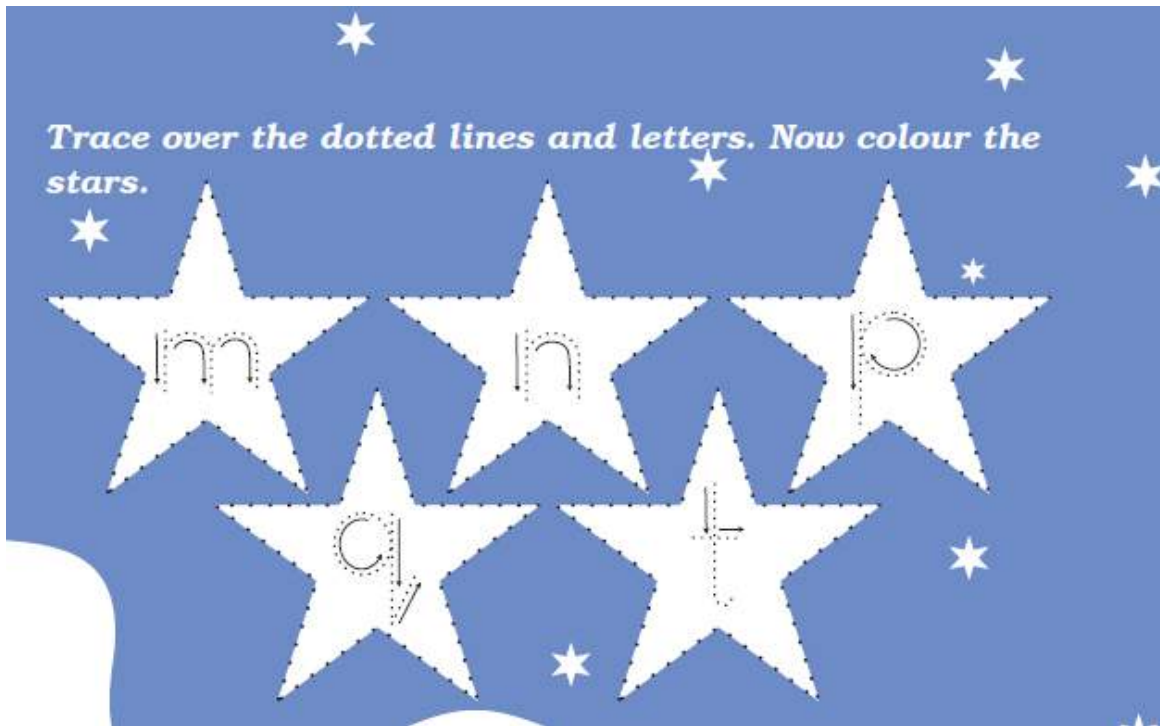

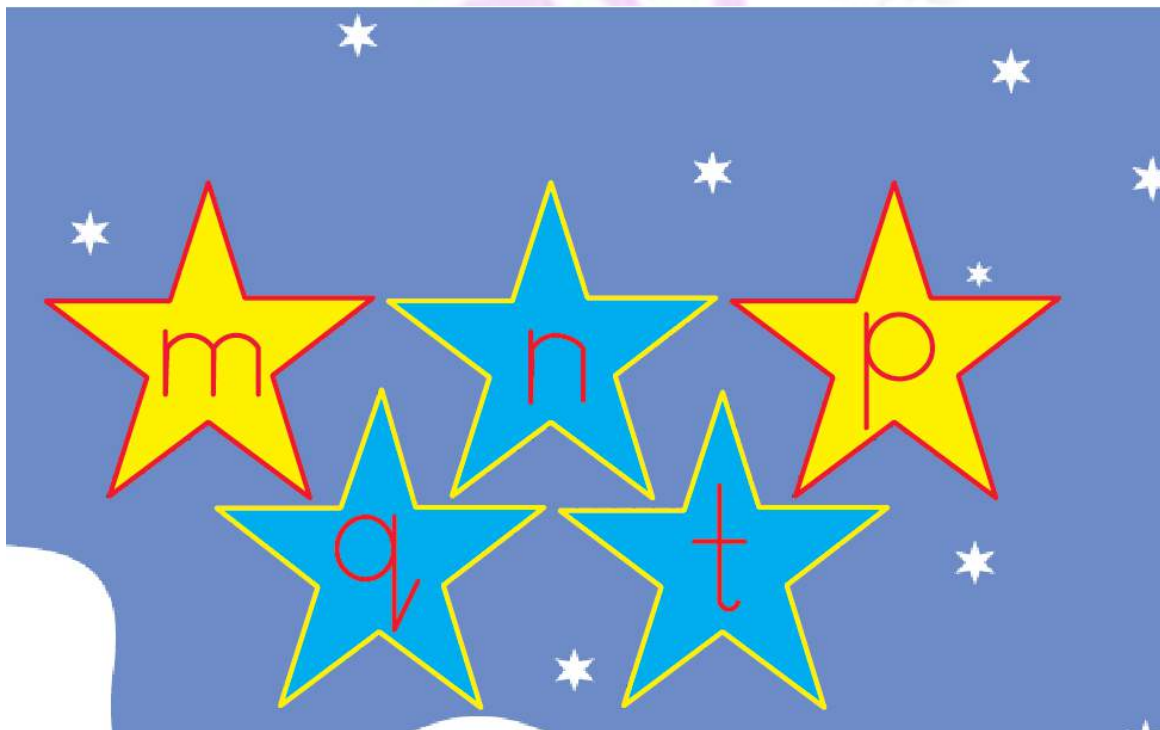
