1. India and India as a subcontinent; Relief and Major Physiographic Divisions of India and they are complementary to each other.
2. Climate : Diversity in climate, Monsoonal Integrity, Natural Vegetation of India.
3. Land-use : Forest Land, Fallow land and agriculture, Soils, Water resources, Characteristics of rainfall; Unequal distribution and failure of rainfall; Floods, Scarcity of water, Flood control, Means of irrigation and drainage, Water budget, River valley and multipurpose projects, Potential and developed Hydro-electricity and they are complementary to each other.
4. Indian Agriculture : With special reference to Punjab: Development of Agriculture after independence, Crops; Major crops, Fabric crops, Commercial crops, Per acre yield, Livestock, Birds, Forests and Wildlife.
5. Mineral Resources : Minerals- Metallic and Non-Metallic, Mineral oil, Exploitation, Distribution and development, Proper development of mineral resources, its proper utilization and conservation.

6. **Manufacturing Industries:** Importance - Agro-based and mineral-based industries, Major industries and localization of industries.
7. **Transportation and Communication:** Role of Roads, Railways, Waterways, Major seaports, Development of airways, Development of means of communication.
8. **People:** The Major resource of a country, Population age, Sex ratio, Structure of population, Rural and urban population, Distribution of population, Density, Qualitative and Quantitative perspective of population.
