- (ii) Number of chocolates each grandmother gets = $20 \div 2 = 10$ chocolates
- (iii) Number of Rasgullas in each bowl = $45 \div 9 = 5$ Rasgullas
- (iv) Number of Apples Doremon should give to each kid $= 27 \div 3 = 9$ apples
- (v) Number of icecreams each child gets = $81 \div 9 = 9$ icecreams
