The 2nd Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC), Disaster Management Exercise was conducted in Orissa, from 11th February 2020 to 13th February 2020. The Disaster Management Exercise was inaugurated by Chief Minister of Orissa Naveen Patnaik. National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) was the nodal agency for organising the BIMSTEC DMEX 2020 Exercise. The 1st BIMSTEC, Disaster Management Exercise was carried out in Nepal in 2017.

BIMSTEC - Disaster Management Exercise (DMEX) - Objectives

This Disaster Management Exercise was carried out with an aim to achieve the following objectives.

- 1. To increase the coordination and cooperation of multi-agencies in the event of floods, earthquakes, storms.
- To evaluate the coordination of multi-stakeholders ranging from international, national, state, district and local level authorities in the event of disasters due to various reasons.
- 3. To evaluate the efficiency of existing procedures of emergency response in the event of disasters.
