Which military force participated in the exercise?	Armies of both the nations participated. The Chinese contingent from the Tibet Military command comprising of 130 personal and the Indian Contingent of similar strength were a part of the exercise		
At which level does this exercise take place?	The exercise Hand-in-Hand took place at company level and Battalion headquarters headed the training <b>Note</b> : A company is called a military unit having a respective number of soldiers.		
Significant activity in the Hand-in-Hand exercise 2019	<ul> <li>Two tactical exercises took place during the training:</li> <li>One on counter-terrorism scenario</li> <li>The other on Humanitarian and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations</li> </ul>

#### Hand-in-Hand Exercise - Facts for UPSC

It is a joint military exercise between the Indian and Chinese Army

The recent edition of Hand-in-Hand exercise took place in 2019 from 7th-20th December at Umroi (Meghalaya)

The aim of the Hand-in-Hand exercise is:

- Practising joint planning
- Conducting exercises meant to counter-terrorism
- Hold training in semi-urban terrains

Activities involved in Hand-in-Hand exercises:

- Lectures
- Drills to handle counter-terrorism operations
- Firing training
- Special Heliborne Operations
- Case studies of various other military operations that have taken place in a counter-terrorism environment

### **India-China Defence Cooperation**

The following points are important with respect to India-China military cooperation:

- 1. In 2018, ninth India-China Annual Defence and Security Dialogue (ADSD) was held in Beijing on 13 November.
- 2. In the International Fleet Review that was conducted at Visakhapatnam in February 2016. Two Chinese naval ships participated.
- 3. Two Indian naval ships, the INS Kolkata and the INS Shakti took part in the International Fleet Review in Qingdao, Shandong in April 2019, held as part of the 70th-anniversary celebrations of the People's Liberation Army (PLA) Navy
- 4. India and China also have a High-Level Dialogue Mechanism on Counter-Terrorism and Security. The mechanism first met in Beijing in September 2016.
