

MASTERING ENGLISH VOCABULARY USING ROOT WORDS: PART 15

AMBUL - The root word 'Ambul' means - to walk, to move around.

The following words are based on the root word, 'Ambul';

1. **AMBULANT** (adj.) - (of a patient) able to walk about: not confined to bed.
2. **AMBULANCE** (noun) - a medically equipped vehicle which transports patients.
3. **SOMNAMBULIST** (noun) - one who walks while asleep.
4. **NOCTAMBULIST** (noun) - one who walks about at night. (noct means -night).
5. **PERAMBULATOR** (noun) – a baby carriage. (Its short form is pram).
6. **FUNAMBULIST** (noun) – an acrobat who walks on a tight rope or a slack rope.
7. **AMBLE** (verb) – walk or move at a slow, relaxed pace.
