AMI/ AMO –

The root word **ami/ amo** means friendly, loveable, peaceful.

The following are the words which are derived from the root word **ami/ amo** :

1. **AMITY** (noun) - friendly relations between people or countries, harmony, peacefulness, friendliness, understanding.
2. **AMICABLE** (adj.) - characterized by friendliness and absence of discord:
 - “An amicable settlement of the dispute”.
3. **AMIABLE** (adj.) - having or displaying a friendly and pleasant manner. “The amiable young man greeted me enthusiastically”.
4. **AMOROUS** (adj.) - inclined to love, showing or expressing love: “an amorous letter”.
5. **ENAMORED** (verb) - to be filled with strong feelings of love or fascination, charmed, smitten.
