Corruption Perception Index

The Corruption Perceptions Index is released by the Transparency International annually. The latest edition is the Corruption Perceptions Index 2019 which was released in January 2020. The index includes the ranks of the 180 countries or territories based on the perceived levels of public sector corruption. The findings of international indices are important for the <u>IAS Exam</u> preparation.

Corruption Perceptions Index - Why in the news?

- Corruption Perceptions Index 2019 was released at the World Economic Forum 2020.
- India's rank in the Corruption Perceptions Index 2019 is 80 among 180 countries. It scored 41 out of 100.
- Corruption Perceptions Index 2020 expected to be released in January 2021.

Ranks in Corruption Perceptions Index 2019

The countries are scored between 0 (Most Corrupt country in the world) and 100 (Least Corrupt Nation in the world). As per the recent index, the facts are as follows:

- 1. **Most Corrupt Country** Somalia (It Scored 9 out 100; and ranked at the bottom 180)
- 2. Least Corrupt Country Denmark (It scored 87 out 100; and ranked at the top 1)

- 5. Sudan (Rank 173)
- 6. Venezuela (Rank 173)
- 7. Yemen (Rank 177)
- 8. Syria (Rank 178)
- 9. South Sudan (Rank 179)
- 10. Somalia (Rank 180)

Ranks of some vibrant Economic Powers in Corruption Perceptions Index 2019

- 1. China 41
- 2. Indonesia 40
- 3. Vietnam 37
- 4. Philippines 34
- 5. USA 23
- 6. United Kingdom 12
- 7. Japan 20

Key Findings of Corruption Perceptions Index 2019

- 1. Little to no improvement in tackling corruption:
 - 1. Since the last eight years, Only 22 countries have shown significant improvement in their scores under CPI.
 - 2. Greece, Guyana and Estonia are among the countries that improved their performance.
 - 3. Canada, Australia and Nicaragua are among the countries to face a slip in their scores.
 - 4. Around 137 countries showed little to no improvement.
- 2. As per the CPI 2019, More corruption is seen in the countries "where big money can flow freely into electoral campaigns and where governments listen only to the voices of wealthy or well-connected individuals."
- 3. Two out three countries scored below 50 out of 100.
- 4. 43 is the average score.
- 5. The major recommendations to tackle corruption are:
 - 1. Managing conflicts of interests
 - 2. Controlling political financing
 - 3. Strengthening electoral integrity
 - 4. Regulating lobbying activities
 - 5. Tackling preferential treatments
 - 6. Empowering citizens
 - 7. Reinforcing checks and balances
