STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER

- All questions are compulsory.
- The question paper will comprise of 6 sections A, B, C, D, E and F with 42 sub parts (questions) in total. The question paper will carry following instructions and marks:-

SECTION- A

Multiple Choice Questions: This section comprises of multiple choice containing 10 questions (3+2+3+2) carrying 1 mark each. **10x1=10**

SECTION- B

Objective Type Questions: This section comprises questions with One Word to One Sentence Answer/Fill in the Blanks /True or False Questions. This section comprises of 16 sub parts carrying 1 mark each. **16x1=**

16 SECTION- C

Short Answer Questions: This section comprises of 8 sub parts (questions) I to VIII carrying 3 marks each. Answer to each question should be in about 80 words. **8x3= 24**

SECTION- D

Long answer: This section comprises of 4 sub parts (questions) I to IV carry 4 marks each with 100% internal choice. Answer of these questions should not exceed 200 words each. **4x4=16**

SECTION- E

Source Based Questions: Two Source (comprehension) based questions of 4 marks each, one from Geography and one from History part. This question comprises of four sub parts shall be carrying 1 mark each. **2X4=8**

SECTION- F

Map Question: This section comprises two questions of map carries 3 marks each from Geography and from history. **3+3=6**
