2. 3rd India – UK Energy for Growth Partnership – Ministerial Energy Dialogue

Context:

The 3rd India – UK Energy for Growth Partnership – Ministerial Energy Dialogue was held virtually.

Details:

- India and the United Kingdom have set in motion concrete action plans for driving clean energy transition in power sector.
- Apart from discussing various issues among which energy transition was a major topic, the dignitaries on both sides welcomed 'Roadmap 2030' for India-U.K. future relations launched by both countries' Prime Ministers during India-U.K. Virtual Summit in May 2021 and identified various future areas of collaboration in line with the roadmap.
- The parties deliberated and agreed on a forward action plan on power and clean transport, renewables, green finance and clean energy research as part of Roadmap 2030, covering a range of topics including smart grids, energy storage, green hydrogen, charging infrastructure, battery storage and need of mobilizing investments in renewable energy along with other proposals under multilateral collaboration.

- The Day was first declared by the UPU Congress held in Tokyo, Japan, in 1969.
- The theme for this year's World Postal Day is 'Innovate to recover'.
- India celebrates 'National Postal Week' from 9 to 15 October.
