About the Global Innovation Index (GII):

- The GII is an index that provides detailed metrics about the innovation performance of 131 countries and economies all over the world.
- It is published by INSEAD, Cornell University, and the <u>World Intellectual Property Organization</u> (<u>WIPO</u>), along with other institutions.
- In the GII 2021, India was ranked 46.
