The Central Bank of India conducts an **online test and personal interview** to recruit candidates for various Specialist Officer (SO) posts. The SO exam pattern of the online test is given in the next section. Candidates who are preparing for SO exams should try to understand the exam pattern and requirements of the exam before starting their preparation. Overview of the Exam Pattern for Central Bank of India SO Posts 2022-23

The selection process of the Central Bank of India Specialist Officer (SO) comprises an **online exam** and **interview**. The online examination consists of Multiple-choice questions (MCQs). The exam is divided into various sections that consist of discipline/stream specific questions, computer knowledge, banking etc. An overview of the Central Bank of India Specialist Officer (SO) exam pattern is given in the table below.

Points to Remember: Central Bank of India SO Posts 2022-23

- The online test will be of **objective** type and each question will have 5 options.
- There is a **negative marking** of **0.25 marks** for each wrong answer, hence candidates should choose the answer options carefully.
- The online test will be conducted in **English and Hindi**. Candidates can select the language as per their preference.
- 20 minutes compensatory time (in addition to 60 minutes) will be allotted to the candidates with disability (who are eligible for compensatory time).
- During the examination, candidates should keep track of the time allotted for the exam. There
 will be a countdown timer in the top right corner of screen that will display the remaining time
 available with the candidate to complete the exam.
- After selecting the appropriate answer for every question, candidates should click on the 'Save and Next' option.
- Candidates can also click on the 'Mark for Review & Next' button, in order to mark the question for review.
- Candidates should **not** press any 'keyboard keys' during the test as this will lock the exam.
