

GIC Assistant Manager 2022 Exam Pattern

GIC Assistant Manager Syllabus and Exam Pattern 2022 will be released along with the official notification of GIC Assistant Manager (Scale- I) 2022. If an aspirant wants to prepare for the GIC Assistant Manager exam, he/she must first understand the GIC Assistant Manager 2022 exam pattern.

GIC Assistant Manager Recruitment consists of two stages: an online written test and a group discussion & personal interview. In this article, we have provided the GIC Assistant Manager exam pattern that includes 4 sections: Quantitative Aptitude, English/Hindi, Reasoning, Computer Literacy and General Awareness.

GIC Assistant Manager 2022 Syllabus:

The GIC Assistant Manager exam is of two parts: Written online exam followed by a descriptive test. The first stage is of 150-marks online written exam. The question paper is divided into three sections, two of which are objective and one of which is subjective. The questions are asked from the following subjects:

- Reasoning Ability
- Quantitative Aptitude
- English/ Hindi Language
- General Awareness
- Computer Knowledge

The descriptive section of the GIC Assistant Manager question paper assesses the candidate's ability to write answers and be creative in the following areas:

- Comprehension
- Essay Writing
- Translation
- Precis

The written test is followed by a personality test/ interview.

GIC Assistant Manager 2022 Written Exam Pattern

The GIC Assistant Manager exam pattern provides applicants with a general idea of the question paper. The GIC Assistant Manager test pattern differs depending on whether the applicant chooses the Hindi or English stream. The test format also varies depending on whether the position is a specialist or a generalist.

The total number of marks for the Written Exam, Group Discussion and Interview will be 200. The GIC Assistant Manager Online Written Exam is broken into three sections, which are as follows:

Part A - Objective Examination



- Part B Objective Examination
- Part C Descriptive Examination

GIC Assistant Manager 2022 Exam: Key Points

- The minimum qualifying marks in the online test are 60% for general and OBC candidates and 50% for SC/ST candidates.
- In objective examinations, there is negative marking for incorrect answers given by applicants.
 For each wrongly marked answer, 0.25 of the total marks allotted to the question will be deducted.
- Candidates who are shortlisted at the end of Phase I will be invited to participate in a group discussion and an interview.
- Minimum qualifying marks for the whole selection procedure (online exam, GD, and interview) 60% for General and OBC and 50% for SC/ST.
