

SEBI Grade A Officer Exam 2022

The SEBI Grade A Recruitment Exam is conducted by the Security Exchange Board of India. SEBI issued a notification to hire individuals for different positions such as General Stream, Legal, IT Engineer, and others. A total of 120 job vacancies were announced. The SEBI Grade A selection method calls for three steps of recruitment. The first step will be an online screening test, an online examination and an interview round.

Recently, the exams for the two stages of SEBI Grade A recruitment were held. On February 20, 2022, a screening test was held, followed by an online examination on March 20, 2022. On April 26, 2022, the Security and Exchange Board of India published the Interview Letter for the SEBI Grade A exam. The chosen applicants will now go to the third stage. Who is a SEBI Grade A Officer?

Candidates who are chosen for SEBI Grade A as Assistant Managers would be required to conduct a variety of tasks. Though a candidate will be placed in a variety of departments upon selection. The SEBI Grade A Assistant Manager position is an entry-level position within the SEBI. The advancement path takes a candidate from Grade B, Grade C, Grade D, Grade E and Grade F all the way to the highest position of Executive Director. Furthermore, the Executive Director has the option of being promoted to Chairman. Some of the important features of an Assistant Manager's job function in SEBI are listed below:

- Amendments of Stock Market by-laws.
- Approval of by-laws for stock markets.
- Inside Financial Markets, detect and prosecute any malpractices.
- Inspection of stock exchange accounts and separate players.
- Protection Trade Suspension in a Stock Exchange.
- Take measures to improve the knowledge of investors in the capital markets.

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Notification

The official notification for the SEBI Grade A 2022 Exam was released on January 05, 2022. The candidates could fill out the form til January 24, 2022. The first stage of the exam was held on February 20, 2022, and the second stage was on March 20, 2022, & April 3, 2022.

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Application Process

Candidates must complete the online application along with full payment once the SEBI Grade A application form is available. Candidates must follow the step-by-step rules for filling out the SEBI Application form before applying for the SEBI Grade A Exam in order to avoid making any mistakes.

The application fee for SEBI Assistant Manager Grade-A 2022 recruiting varies depending on the category and is as follows:

Category	Application Fees
General/OBC/EWS	₹ 1000/- (Application fees cum intimation charges)
SC/ ST/ PWD	₹ 100/- (As intimation charges)

While filling out the application form candidates will be required to select the examination centres for the Stage 1 and Stage 2 of the examination.

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must fulfil the qualifying standards set by the organising authorities, which include age limit, educational qualification, nationality, and others, in order to apply for the SEBI Grade A examination. The maximum upper age limit is 30 years, however, reserved category candidates may be given age relaxation. The overview of the eligibility criteria is:

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Syllabus

For both phase 1 and phase 2 examinations, the SEBI Grade A syllabus includes courses in commerce, finance, management, costing, economics, and other subjects. The first is the Screening Test, which qualifies applicants for the Online Examination's second stage. All applicants who pass the online examination will be called to the personal interview in phase three.

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Results

After the Pahse 1 and Phase 2 of the SEBI Grade A 2022 exam was over, the Security and Exchange Board of India revealed the results within a few days. The SEBI 2022 results are available on the official website in the form of a PDF including the roll number of qualifying candidates for those who took the test.

Candidates who perform very well in the first phase advance to the next level. The overall qualifying percentage for Phase 1 is 40%, while the qualifying percentage for Phase 2 is 50%. The final SEBI Grade A results comprise 85 percent of the Phase II result and 15 percent of the interview. Candidates who make it to the SEBI Grade A final list successfully will be given the desired position. The Phase I results will have no bearing on the SEBI Grade A final results.

SEBI Grade A Exam 2022: Salary

One of the primary factors attracting applicants to this post is the SEBI Grade A Salary that any candidate would receive if recruited as Assistant Manager at the Security and Exchange Board of India. Anyone working as an Assistant Manager would receive a handsome salary, as well as several bonuses and privileges that come with the SEBI Grade A Salary.

The pay scale of Grade A manager is **INR 28150-1550(4)-343501750(7)-46600-EB-1750(4) -53600-2000(1)-55600 (17 years)**. (EB is an abbreviation for Efficiency Bar).

Details related to the salary structure of an Assistant Manager (Grade A) is given below:

- The SEBI Grade A officer basic pay would be INR 28,150/- in the first year. Followed by fouryearly increments of INR 1550/-.
- After 5 years, the starting salary will be INR 34,450/-.
- From the sixth to the twelfth year of the service (7 years), the officers will receive an annual increase of INR1,750/-.
- The following four-yearly increments would be INR1,750/-. As a result, the basic pay is INR 53,600/-.



• The next yearly increment would be INR 2,000/-, bringing the base wage to INR 55,600 at the end of the 17th year.

Aside from the base salary, each SEBI Grade A officer receives the following bonuses and benefits:

- Monthly Petrol Allowance (100-200 litres)
- Local Allowances
- Quarterly Allowances
- Dearness Allowances
- House Rent Allowance (optional)

Taking into account allowances, the gross emolument scale is approx. **Rs. 1, 07,000/- per month** without accommodation and INR 73,000/- per month with accommodation.
