Syllabus: GS 3 - ECONOMY; Changes in Industrial policy and their effects on Industrial growth

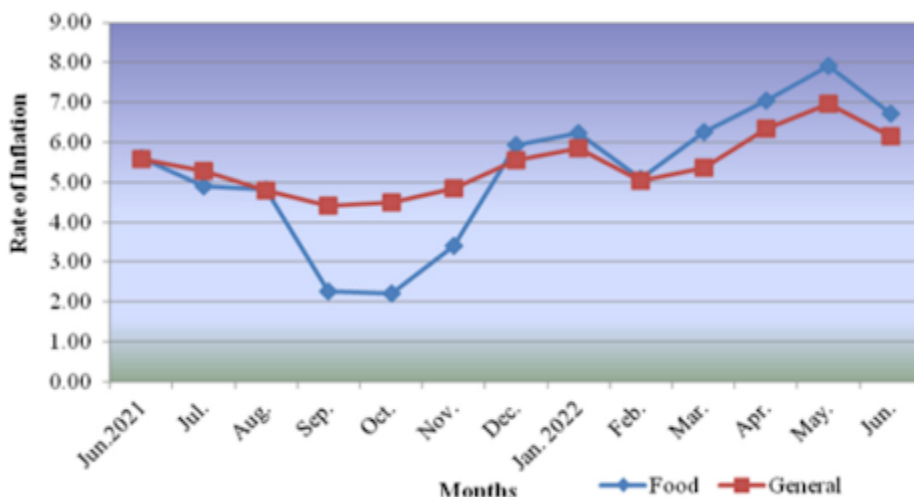
Prelims: CPI - IW

Details:

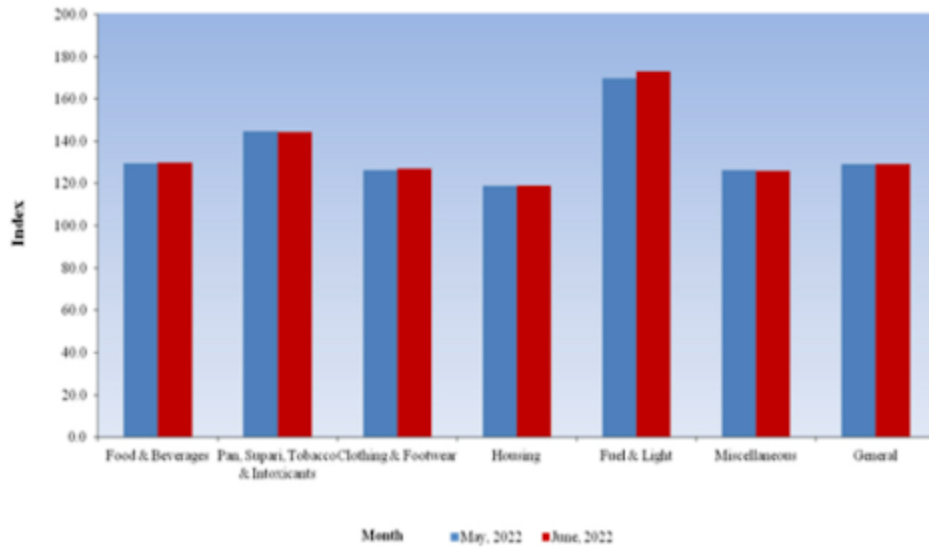
- Released by the Labor Bureau, Ministry of Labor and employment on a monthly basis.
- The All-India CPI-IW for June, 2022 increased by 0.2 points
- The maximum upward pressure in the current index came from Food & Beverages group contributing 0.20 percentage points to the total change.
