

## SBI SO Syllabus 2022

State Bank of India conducts various examinations annually for recruiting employees for SBI Specialist Officer posts according to vacancies. It administers the SBI SO exam to recruit Specialist Officers for regular or contract positions as Assistant Managers, Engineers, Officers, Architects, Testers, Managers, and Analysts, among others. It is a golden opportunity for all the candidates who consider working at SBI as an enticing prospect. To effectively study for the exam, interested applicants must be well-versed with the SBI SO Syllabus and Exam Pattern.

In this article, we'll look into the topic-wise distribution of the SBI SO Syllabus 2022 for the different SO exams conducted by SBI annually. Candidates willing to know in detail about the recruitment process can visit the linked article [SBI SO Notification](#).

Generally, the State Bank of India releases a single notification for the recruitment of Specialist Officers. However, starting SBI SO 2020, various recruitment announcements for various positions have been made available on the official SBI website. This year too, the selection process varies for different Specialist Officer posts for which different notifications have been released by the SBI. ### SBI SO Exam Pattern

Candidates applying for the SBI SO exam are tested on the basis of an online examination and interview process. The SBI SO exam consists of two Papers – Paper 1 and Paper 2.

- Paper 1 comprises of questions from:
  - Reasoning Ability
  - Quantitative Aptitude
  - English Language
- Paper 2 comprises of questions from:
  - Professional Knowledge

The distribution of marks of each section totally depends on the type of SBI SO post that a candidate has applied for at the time of online application.

**Important Points to Remember:**

- Candidates qualifying the online examination are eligible for the next process which is the Interview round.
- Usually, the duration of the Paper 1 is 90 minutes and Paper 2 is timed at 70 minutes for every SBI SO exam.
- The marks scored in Paper I are qualifying in nature and will not be considered in the final merit list.
- Candidates will get one mark for each correct answer and a quarter of the marks, 0.25 marks, will be deducted for every wrong answer. However, candidates will not be penalised for an unanswered question.
- The marks earned by applicants in the Professional Knowledge section and the Interview phase will be taken into account when announcing the final list of candidates who have been shortlisted.
- The candidates with the top merit rankings in each category will be chosen for the jobs. If more than one candidate gets the required score (common marks at the cut-off point), they will be ranked in the merit list according to their age in descending order.

After combining the scores from the Professional Knowledge Test (out of 150 marks) and the interview (out of 25 marks), the final merit list will be determined. The score will be weighted as follows:

The Specialist Officer examination covers all of the significant subjects and chapters included in the SBI SO Syllabus. The online written exam will be based on General Aptitude and Professional Knowledge. The following lists the subjects that fall under each of these headings.
