



Viral Poultry Disease

Newcastle / Ranikhet Disease

Queen Honey Bee

- ❖ Large
- ❖ Usually only **one** in a colony
- ❖ Diploid, fertile female
- ❖ Lays both fertilised and unfertilised eggs



Apiculture

Drone Honey Bee

- ❖ Smaller than queen
- ❖ ~200-300 in a colony
- ❖ Haploid, fertile male
- ❖ Fertilises the queen's eggs

Worker Honey Bee

- ❖ Smaller than queen
- ❖ ~200-300 in a colony
- ❖ Haploid, fertile male
- ❖ Fertilises the queen's eggs



Apiculture

Points that are important for successful beekeeping:

Knowledge of bees and their habits

Selection of proper location for keeping beehives

Management of beehives during different seasons

Proper handling and collection of honey & beeswax


Catching and hiving of swarms



Apiculture

Advantages

- ❖ Bees pollinate many crop species (sunflower, *Brassica*, apple and pear)
- ❖ They increase pollination efficiency and hence enhance the yield of the crops



Fishery



Fishery

- ❖ Human used spears, fishing hooks, etc, to capture fishes
- ❖ As population grew, demand for fish and its products grew

Fishery

- ❖ Later, mechanized version of fishing equipment was used for capturing fishes (in bulk)
- ❖ Led to the development of fishery industry

- ❖ Fishery is an industry devoted to the catching, processing or selling of fish, shellfish or other aquatic animals.






