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4. The candidates are advised to be present at their respective places of examination at **09.00 a.m.**. Late arrival beyond **half hour** after the commencement of examination in each subject shall disqualify the candidate from appearing at the said examination. Candidate(s) shall not be allowed to leave the Examination hall before **10.00a.m.**
5. Practical Examination in Science (General & CWSN) /Geography (CWSN)/ History (CWSN) will commence from **01/03/2023 onward** and in Pre-Vocational / CWSN special subjects will commence from **13/03/2023 onward**. However the detailed programme of the practical examination will be notified later through the Head of the Institutions. The candidates are advised that they should get the same ascertained from the Head of the Institutions.
6. The Practical examination in NSQF Subjects will commence from **03/03/2023 onward** and will be conducted by National Skill Development Council, New Delhi.
7. Repeater Candidates of April 2022 registered for April 2023 Examination and not appeared in the First Term shall answer with entire syllabus (80 marks).
8. Repeater candidates of April 2021 and prior registered for April 2023 Examination shall answer with entire Syllabus (80 marks).
9. Improvement candidates registered for April 2023 Examination shall answer with entire syllabus (80 marks).
10. All important and relevant instructions for answering the public examination, circulated vide this office circular **No. 53 dated 04/10/2006** shall be strictly followed by all students.
11. Under no circumstances examinations shall be postponed even though any day is declared as a public holiday.
12. **SOP's for conduct of examination will be intimated well in advance.**
