



# Find Your Friend

## Number of players

We need a group of children to make the game more interesting.  
The ideal number would be 10-15.

## Parental involvement

Just sit back and watch your children enjoy the game!  
You can also encourage your child to play this game in school, which will boost them to make new friends and expand their groups.

## Rules of the game

1. Each player in a group must have the name of another player within the same group. Note: This must be played with a mix of new and old friends.
2. They would be assigned one question about any of their other friends in the same group. For instance, Player 1 would ask a question from the list: 'Which friend likes apples the most?'
3. They must find the person who answers the question correctly. If more than one person answers the question, it adds to the fun.
