

#### Flag of Nepal









In South Asia, Nepal is a landlocked country, bordered by China in the north and India in the south, east and west. Its topography can be mainly divided into three types of regions - the Himalayas, Hills and Terai.

Landlocked (adjective) - Almost or completely surrounded by land

Nepal has the highest elevation change of any other country on the planet. The world's highest peak, Mount Everest, stands at 29,035 feet (8.85 kilometres) in Nepal.

Altitude (noun) - The height above sea level

Nepal's topography and geography make it vulnerable to natural disasters such as floods and earthquakes

**Topography (noun)** - The physical features of an area of land, especially the position of its rivers, mountains, etc.; the study of these features.

**Geography (noun)** - The scientific study of the earth's surface, physical features, divisions, products, population, etc.



Sherpas are mountain people that live at altitudes of over 12,000 feet (3,658 meters). They have been well known for accompanying visitors on steep, high-altitude climbs.

**Sherpa (noun)** - A member of the Himalayan tribes that often guide people in the mountains

Spruce, fir, cypress, juniper, and birch trees grow in Nepal's forests while tigers, leopards, deer, rhinoceros and musk deer feature predominantly in its diverse fauna. In Nepal, there are 185 different species of mammals while more than 850 bird species have been identified.

Nepal is home to 101 ethnic groups who speak 92 different languages.

**Ethnic (adjective)** - Connected with or belonging to a group of people that share a cultural tradition

Daal, bhat, and tarkari (lentil soup, rice and vegetables) are a typical Nepali dinner, often served with pickle. Curried meat is widely consumed, yet many people save it for special occasions. Momos (steamed or fried dumplings) are one of Nepal's most popular snacks.




