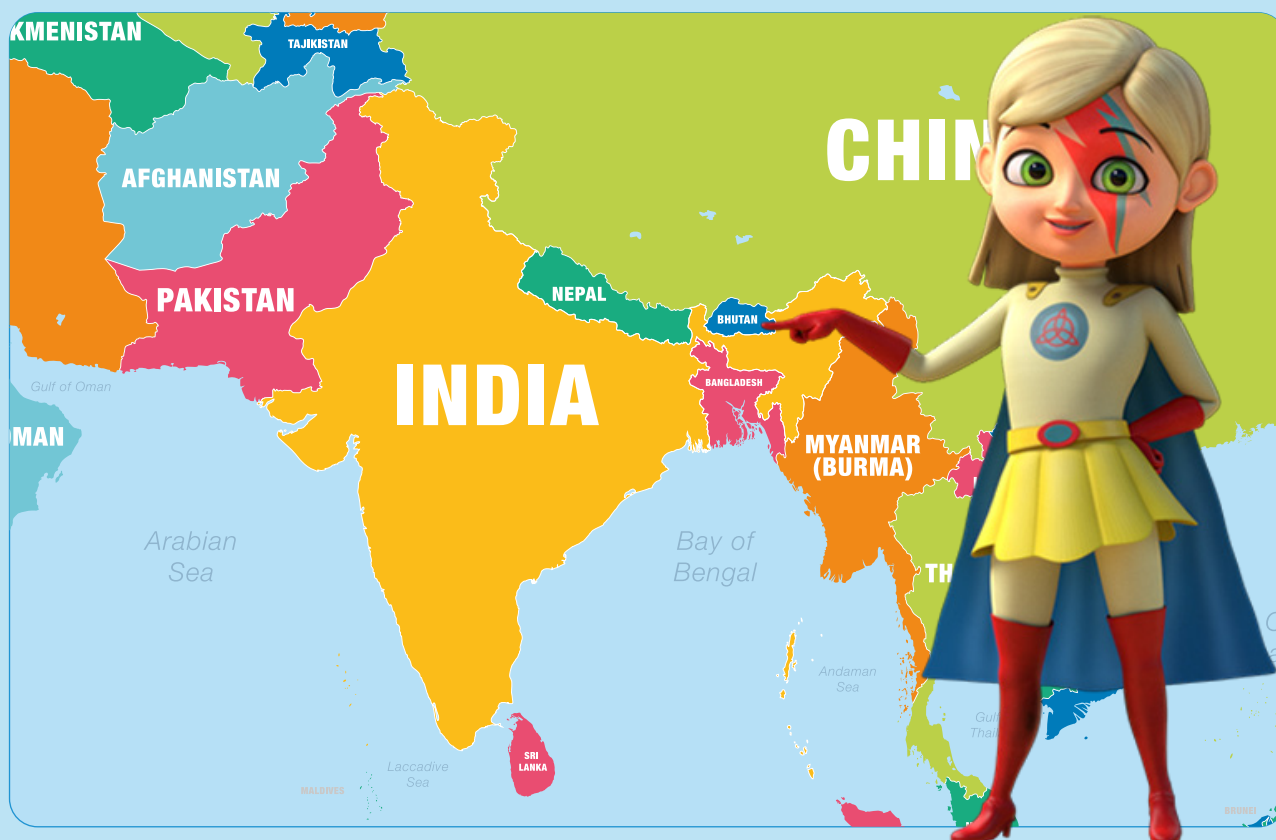

Bhutan is positioned in the eastern ridges of the Himalayan mountain range. It is sandwiched between China and India, with many of its regions still difficult to be accessed. The national colours of Bhutan are yellow and orange, and its emblem is a dragon known as the Druk (Thunder Dragon).

Ridge (noun) - A high pointed area near the top of a mountain

Access (noun) - A way of entering or reaching a place

Emblem (noun) - A design or picture that represents a country or an organisation

The economy of Bhutan is largely based on hydropower, agriculture, and forestry, which constitute the main livelihood for more than half of Bhutan's population. Bhutan's hydroelectricity exports comprise 25% of the government's total revenue and 40% of total exports. Because of the differences in elevation and climate, there is very limited land usable for agriculture.

Economy (noun) - The relationship between production, trade, and the supply of money in a particular country or region

Livelihood (noun) - A means of earning money to live

Elevation (noun) - The height of a place, especially its height above sea level



Mountains define the landscape of this country. Therefore, constructing infrastructure like roads is very difficult and expensive. As a result, the industrial activity of this country is primarily of the cottage industry type.

Landscape (noun) – Everything you can see when you look across a large area of land, especially in the country

Infrastructure (noun) – The basic systems and services that are necessary for a country or an organisation to run smoothly, for example buildings, transport, and water and power supplies

Cottage industry (noun) – A small business in which the work is done by people in their homes

Many children do not yet have access to public education in the country. The number of Bhutanese with adequate training in medical, engineering, education, and other sectors continues to fall short of the country's demands

Public school (noun) - A free local school set up by a government
