Myanmar is a Southeast Asian nation that was earlier known as Burma. Following more than 100 years of colonial rule, it became an independent state in the January of 1948.

**Colonial (adjective) -** Connected with or belonging to a country that controls another country

Myanmar is a tropical country with hilly areas. Mount Hkakabo, Myanmar's highest peak at 19,296 feet, is found in the Kumon Range in the north (5.88 km). In the wettest areas, evergreen rainforests thrive. There are many natural harbours in the country too.

**Tropic (noun)-** One of the two imaginary lines traced around the world: 23° 26′ north (the Tropic of Cancer) or south (the Tropic of Capricorn) of the equator

**Tropics (noun)** - The area between the two tropics, which is the hottest part of the world

**Rainforest (noun)** - A thick forest usually found in the tropical parts of the world that have a lot of rain

**Harbour (noun)** - An area of water on the coast, protected from the open sea by strong walls, where ships can take shelter



Myanmar is a country with a diverse ethnic population. The Burmans, its largest ethnic group, makes up more than half of the population. Myanmar also has a large number of indigenous languages, as opposed to dialects.

**Ethnic (adjective) -** Connected with or belonging to a group of people that share a cultural tradition

**Dialect (noun) -** The form of a language that is spoken in one area with grammar, words, and pronunciation that may be different from other forms of the same language

**Indigenous (adjective) -** Coming from a particular place and having lived there for a long time before other people came there; relating to, belonging to or developed by these people

The 12 seasonal festivals on the Burmese calendar are observed in accordance with the Myanmar people's various religious, social, political, and educational customs and traditions. This is the legacy of Myanmar's ancient thousand-year-old history, the knowledge of which has been passed down through generations.

**Legacy (noun) -** A situation that exists now because of events and actions that took place in the past
