South Korea is a country in East Asia. This mountainous nation is surrounded by the sea on three sides.


Hanbok is a traditional South Korean dress. Many of the natives also wear clothes made from materials like hemp, ramie, cotton, and silk to protect them from the cold and heat. However, in the past, the people here preferred simple, white clothes over fancy attire, which is why they were often called 'The White-clad Folk'.

Clad (adjective) - Wearing a particular type of clothing

Attire (noun) - Clothes, especially fine or formal ones

The traditional Korean home is called a Hanok. These homes stay warm thanks to a prehistoric underfloor heating system called Ondol. The word 'Ondol' means warm stones.

Prehistoric (adjective) – Connected with the time in history before information was written down



The people of South Korea prefer hot and spicy food.

Their traditional food relies heavily on the process of fermentation, which, in their case, usually lasts for many months to years.

Some popular South Korean food items are kimchi (fermented salted vegetables), jeotgal (salted seafood), bibimbap (mixed rice) and jeon (pancakes).

Until recently, South Korea was mainly an agricultural country, with their harvests and other seasonal cultural events based on the lunar calendar.

Harvest (noun) - The act of cutting and gathering crops
