Indonesia is a country in Southeast Asia. It lies between the Indian and Pacific oceans. It is a group of more than 17,500 islands that form an archipelago.

Archipelago (noun) - A group of islands and the sea around them

Indonesia is a tropical country that mostly has only two weather conditions — Rainy and Dry. From April to October, most of the country experiences a dry climate, and from November to March, it rains most of the time. Climate change has made it harder to tell when each weather condition will start and end.

Indonesia has different landforms because of its geographic location. Apart from gorgeous views, it is also home to old temples and historical treasures. Bali is also a well-known beach vacation destination for tourists.



During an excavation, a fossil of an older human species was found along with some of the tools used by them. This showed that 'the early human' had lived in the Indonesian archipelago roughly 1.5 million years ago. The remarkable fossil, named Homo Floresiensis, is thought to be one of the ancestors of modern humans.

Excavation (noun) - The process of digging up old buildings or things that have been buried for a long time.

Ancestor (noun) - A family member who lived a long time ago.
