Qatar is a nation located on the eastern side of the Arabian Peninsula. It is made up of many islands like Halul, Shraouh, Al-Asshat, and others. The capital city is Doha, where more than half the people in Qatar live.

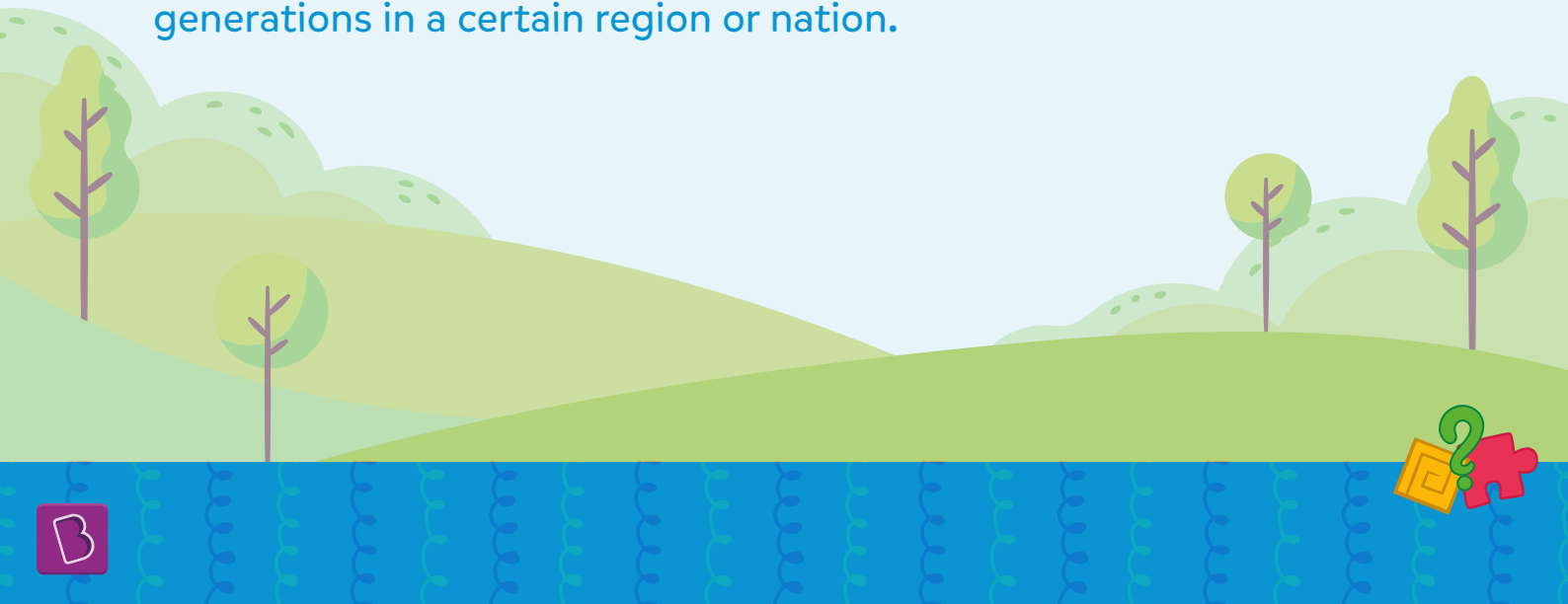
Peninsula (noun) – A part of land that is nearly or completely surrounded by water and connects to a bigger piece of land.

Qatar is mostly a flat, windblown desert with hot humid summers and dry subtropical weather with little rainfall. Several small hills can be found along its western and northern coasts. The south and southeast coasts are lined with sand dunes and salt flats called sabkhahs. You would be surprised to know that Qatar has no permanent freshwater bodies like lakes and ponds.

Dune (noun) – A small sand hill made by the wind close to the water or in a desert.

Cultural activities, such as reading poetry and sharing stories about the past, are a big part of public life in Qatar. Folk dances like Al Ardah are often performed at celebrations and other events.

Folk dance (noun) – A dance that has been performed for generations in a certain region or nation.



In Qatar, calligraphy and architecture have been the most important forms of visual art for a long time. With the conception of the Qatari Fine Arts Society, the art scene has grown quickly in the last few decades.

Calligraphy (noun) – Beautiful handwriting produced with a special pen or brush.

Architecture (noun) – The art and science of creating structures.

The Qatar Museums Authority is a key part of making cultural activities more popular. There are several museums and art galleries in Qatar, such as the Museum of Islamic Art and the Mathaf Arab Museum of Modern Art.

Art Gallery (noun) – A building that displays paintings and other works of art to the general public.

Qatar has become one of the most important places for business and tourism in the world. It plays host to a number of highly successful major international events, such as the 2022 FIFA World Cup (football), which is scheduled for November-December.
