Maldives is one of the tiniest countries in the world. Maldives is a north-central Indian Ocean island nation. It consists of 1,200 coral islands and sandbanks forming atolls.

Atoll (noun) – A type of coral island that looks like a ring and has a lake of seawater in the middle.

Coral (noun) – A hard red, pink, or white substance that forms at the bottom of the ocean from the bones of very small animals.

The southwest monsoon brings the rainy season to the Maldives, which lasts from May to August. From December to March, mild dry winds mark the onset of the northeast monsoon. On average, the temperature ranges from 24 to 30°C.

The majority of the residents in the Maldives belong to the Maldivian ethnic group. Different groups migrated to the islands over the country's history. Apart from Dhivehi, Arabic, Hindi and English are also spoken in the country.

Migrate (verb) – To live and/or work in another town, nation, etc.



Since the Maldives is in the Indian Ocean, their cuisine primarily consists of seafood, coconuts, rice, vegetables, and fruits. The Maldivian cuisine is highly influenced by Indian, Arab and Thai cuisines. Fish and rice are the main foods in the country. Meat and chicken are only eaten on special occasions.

The Maldives' economy relies heavily on tourism and fishing. The people here are also highly skilled in building and repairing boats, and making clothes. A few even make a living by growing and selling coconuts, fruits, and vegetables!
