Across the Solar System with Mila







Scientists believe Earth formed 10-20 million years ago. Except for Earth, all other planets are named after Greek and Roman deities. The name Earth is Germanic and means 'ground'.

Our planet, Earth, is the third one in line from the Sun. Did you know that sunlight takes about 8 minutes to reach the Earth? It makes one trip around the Sun every 365 days and 6 hours. To make up for the extra 6 hours, a leap day is added to our calendar year every 4 years.

Our Earth, the green planet, is the only planet that we are absolutely sure hosts life at present. Earth is the Solar System's fifth-largest planet. It is the only known planet to have stable bodies of liquid water on its surface for extended periods of time. Did you know that water covers 70 per cent of the planet's surface?







The Earth's atmosphere consists of 78% nitrogen, 21% oxygen, and small traces of other gases, such as carbon dioxide and hydrogen. Our atmosphere is designed to protect us from meteoroids that may be moving in our way because the vast majority of them disintegrate in our atmosphere before reaching the Earth's surface.

Meteor (noun) - A space rock that leaves a bright trail across the night sky as it falls through the Earth's atmosphere and burns up.

Disintegrate (verb) - To break into small pieces, come apart, and be destroyed

Earth is made up of complex, interconnected systems that are constantly changing. There is still a lot we don't know about Earth. And this is where satellites are helpful. They collect data on the weather, oceans, soil, crops, and more to help us understand our beautiful planet better.

Satellite (noun) – An electronic device that travels around the Earth or another planet in space. It's used for radio, TV, and information gathering.
