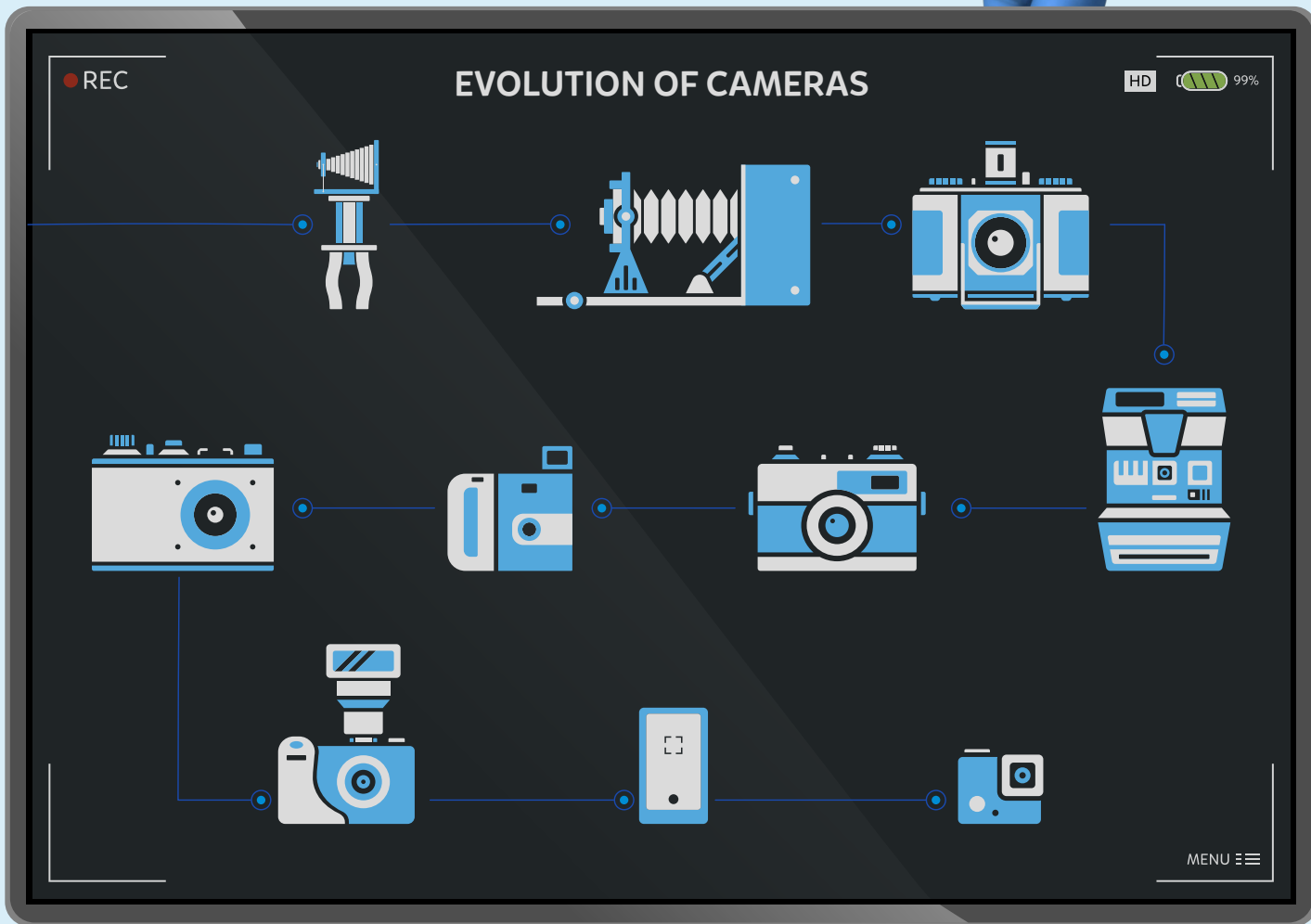

# ACTIVITY 1

Mila talks tech!

# CAMERA



We use cameras to save memories of important events like birthdays. Photos show people and things almost as they look in the real world. Before cameras, people used drawings and paintings to share what they have seen with others.

The first camera was named Camera Obscura, meaning “darkroom” in Latin. It was a dark room with a small hole in the wall to let the light in that formed a shadow of the object/person on the wall. An artist would trace the shadow on the wall. Since then, the camera evolved but was still expensive, difficult to use and heavy. In the 1800s, George Eastman improved the camera by making it smaller and designed the roll film. With the press of a button, the roll film inside the camera would capture the image that helped to print out the exact photo.

In 1986, the Nikon SVC released the first digital single-lens reflex (DSLR) camera with multiple lenses. It was made by Nikon, a company in Japan. Digital cameras, with their special sensors, were very popular in the 2000s.



By 2010, almost all smartphones had a digital camera. Now mobile phones have camera phones that help share photos with other phones and devices. But most camera phones can't compete with bigger cameras in low light. We will have to wait and see how cameras are going to change and improve with time.
