

We used traditional methods like postal mail for communication, but everything changed when the radio was introduced.

Radios send information without using any wires. It works by turning sounds or signals into radio waves. Radio waves are created by the flow of electricity that can move through the air that we cannot see. The radio catches these radio waves and changes them into the sounds, words, and music we hear. A broadcast is when radio signals are sent to several radio receivers at the same time for people to listen.

In the 1920s, the radio became an important part of people's lives. More than 500 stations broadcasted news, music, sports, drama, and many shows. Radio was a big part of home entertainment until the 1950s.







Radio waves are used in radio broadcasts and modern technology like television, mobile phones, satellites, and navigation. Police officers, firefighters and other people who help in emergencies talk to each other using a radio emergency communication system. It works like a mobile phone, but the range is shorter, and those using it must have the same kind of radio. Even today, radios play a big role in communication.
