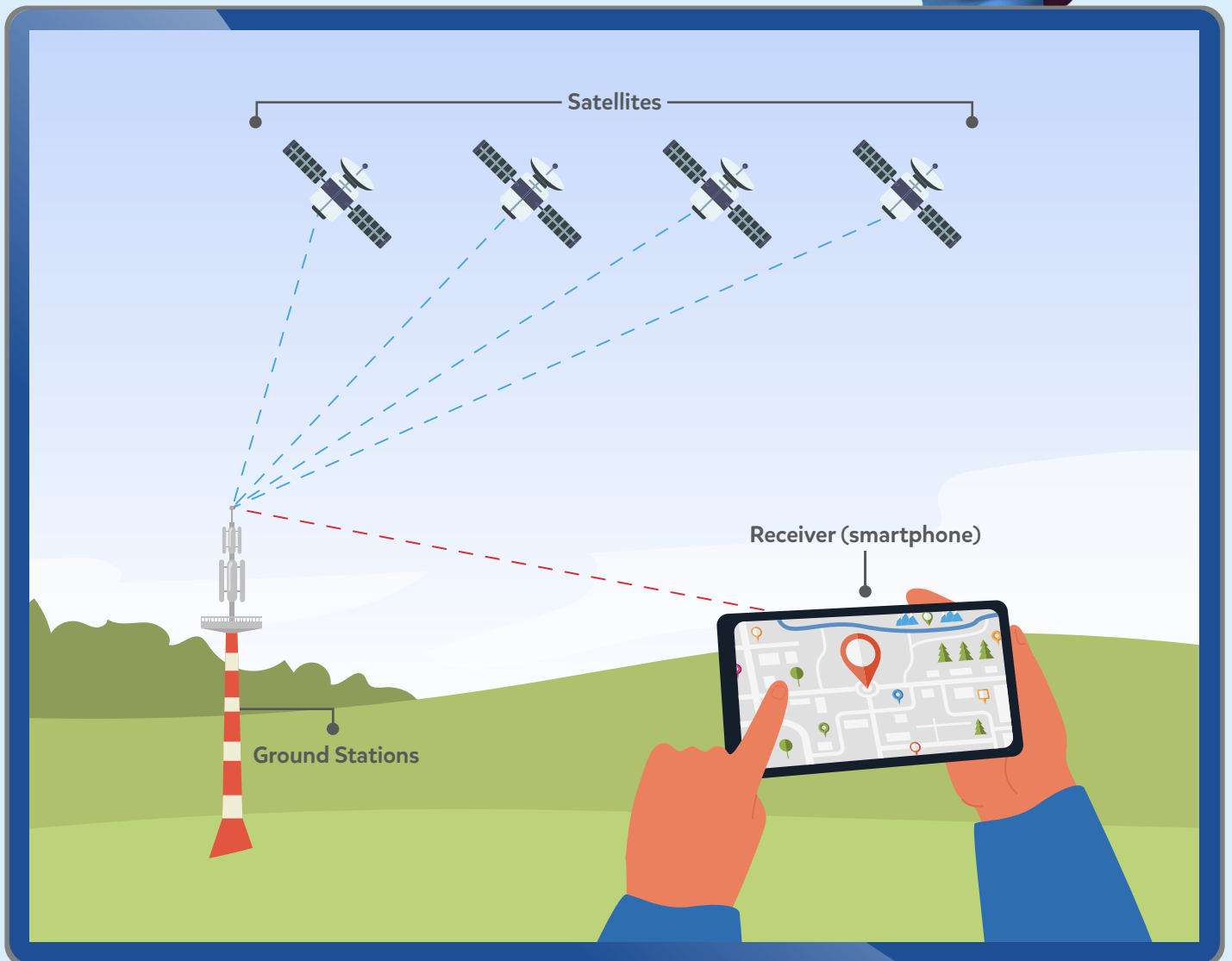

## GPS

(Global Positioning System)



A long time back, people needed to read maps and study the stars to know where they were and how to get to where they were going. It was hard! Today, we can find out where we are and how to get to a location with a GPS (Global Positioning System) receiver like a smartphone.

GPS trackers use signals sent by **satellites** that circle the Earth to figure out where we are on the planet. GPS can tell you where a person or an object, like a car or a parcel, is at that time and which way it is moving. GPS can also give us the best routes to get to a place, and the time we will need to get there.

**Satellite (noun)** – An electronic device that circles the Earth or any other larger object in space to collect information or is used for communication.



GPS is helpful during an emergency since it allows emergency services like police, ambulances, etc., to find you even if you don't tell them where you are. If your car has a **GPS device** in it and suddenly gets stolen, you can easily find the car and track it down. A **GPS device** such as a phone or a bracelet can help you keep track of an older person who might forget their address and get lost on the way. GPS also helps scientists **predict** the weather, watch out for earthquakes, and protect the environment.

**Device (noun)** – A thing or piece of equipment that was made to do a specific job.

**Predict (verb)** – To say what you think will happen in the future based on information that you have now.
