You must be wondering why? The reason is that drawing is one of the easiest ways to express one's thoughts and ideas. It lets the visual artists put the picture in their mind on paper. For example, an architect might draw a building on paper and figure out where to put the doors, windows and other things to make the building look nice from the outside. Doors and windows of different sizes and shapes will be put in the drawing. They will then look at how the building will look with different decorations. Once the architect is happy with the drawing, they will start working on making the building for real. That's a great way to use drawing at the workplace, don't you think?

While drawing, you are expected to pull ideas from your mind, your memories or even from your surroundings, like trees, fruits, chairs and so on. The rough draft, plan or outline of the drawing is known as a sketch. Drawing people requires you to know drawing really well. These different types of drawings are often known as object drawing, nature drawing and human figure drawings.

To draw, you do not need many supplies. Paper and pencil will do. Some people also use pastels, pens or even charcoal to draw. Drawings are mostly made up of lines. Artists also use different techniques to do shading, add texture and show depth.

Observation is a very important part of drawing. It is the act of carefully watching something or someone. It teaches you to focus and pay attention to shapes, patterns, how things are put together or how two or more things are similar or different. You need to put in great effort to learn these things. While drawing is a hard subject to master, you may also draw for fun and relaxation.
